OFFICIAL NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS
LOCAL UNION 1289, IBEW

The nominations for Officers of Local Union 1289 will take place at the Southern monthly Union Meeting starting at 6:00 p.m. on May 19, 2026 at the Local Meeting Hall located at 3301 Route 138, Wall, NJ 07719. Nominations for Officers of Local Union 1289 will also take place at the Northern location with a special called meeting starting at 6:00 p.m. on May 20, 2026 at the Clinton Fire Department located at 1 New Street, Clinton, NJ 08809.

Anyone desiring to be nominated must be present or signify his/her willingness in writing. Verbal or Written acceptance of a nomination must be presented at the meeting when nominations are held. No member may be a candidate for more than one (1) office and if nominated for more than one (1) office, must declare for which office he/she will be a candidate.

Nominations will proceed in the order of officers as listed in the IBEW Constitution and the term of office shall be three (3) years.

Additionally, nominations will be held for delegates and alternate delegates to the International Convention.

In order to be nominated, a member must have a minimum of two (2) years of continuous good standing in Local Union 1289. Good standing means that a member is current in their payment of dues and has been for the two (2) years preceding the nominations.

An election judge and tellers have been appointed. None of these may be a candidate for any office.

The election of officers shall take place between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on June 18, 2026 at both of the Local Union Meeting Halls located at Local 400, 3301 Route 138, Wall, NJ 07719 and Clinton Fire Department, 1 New Street, Clinton, NJ 08809.


Absentee ballots shall be available to any member upon written request to the election judge. Such requests will be accepted up to five days prior to the date of the election. No one receiving an absentee ballot will be entitled to vote at the polls without first presenting the election judge with the unused ballot. Absentee ballots received at the post office box after 3:00 p.m. on June 13, 2026, will not be counted.

The counting of the ballots will take place following the closing of both polls and the results shall be announced immediately. A complete listing of the results shall be posted on all Union bulletin boards by the close of business on the day following the election.

Candidates shall be entitled to an observer at the polling place and during the counting of the ballots. Observers may not interfere with the orderly procedure of the election. There shall be no campaigning or electioneering at the polls or within 50 feet from the entrance to the polling places. No postings except instructions shall be permitted at the polling places.

In the event that no candidate receives a majority vote, a runoff election will take place on July 9, 2026 from 6:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. at both of the Local Union Meeting Halls located at Local 400, 3301 Route 138, Wall, NJ 07719 and Clinton Fire Department, 1 New Street, Clinton, NJ 08809.
